Grapes

100% Chardonnay vintage 2012, hand picking.



Vineyard, soil and viticulture

Aspects: altitude over 800 feet on the sea level, located in the middle of Trieste's Kars, west facing. Yields per hectare: 7.000 plants and 500/600 gr per stump, training system single guyot. Oldest vines of the historical parcels nestled between Adriatic Sea and San Pelagio's church.



Cellar

White vinification, gentle and soft pressed, 12 months of ageing in old French barriques followed by stabilization, 24 months in stain steel tank. Unfiltered bottled. Then the wine sleeps for more than 60 months in bottle.

ABV 12,5%

Vintage report

A sparkling spring with good amount of rainfall and a hotter summer than average resulting in a slightly early vintage with excellent performance.



Tasting note

Intense crystal clear yellow. Elegant and authentic. Impressive bouquet, wide and deep with yellow ripe fruits, zesty and creamy, buttery note. Underlined by a remarkable freshness, salinity and high minerality despite the long ageing, thanks to red soil rich in minerals, the sea breeze influence and the Bora wind. A long living rare white. Service temperature $10 - 12\,^{\circ}\text{C}$.
